

# Silver & Turquoise Ball

**ONE OF THE COMMUNITY'S OLDEST ANNUAL EVENTS**, the Silver & Turquoise Ball began more than 60 years ago as a way of recognizing the efforts of volunteers who were preserving Tucson's heritage.

Over time, the evening has evolved from a simple dinner to an elegant black-tie affair, ideally suited to showing off the event's namesake accessories. A gourmet dinner, two dance bands, a dessert bar and a late-night cabaret are all part of the fun.

Proceeds benefit the work of the Patronato Mission San Xavier del Bac, dedicated to the Mission, which can trace its origins back to the 17th century. The Silver & Turquoise Board of Hostesses is one of the largest donors to the ongoing conservation of San Xavier.

Chairwoman Rebecca Sundt has led the 50-member board in their yearlong work to plan the ball. The evening will kick off with a marachi fanfare, and end with dancing under the stars in the historic environs of the Arizona Inn.
